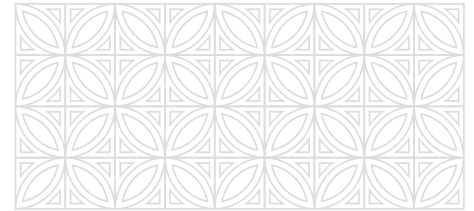


Qatar Airways in the Blue Sky of Canada

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NEW HORIZONS AHEAD FOR QATAR AIRWAYS IN CANADA

Recent years have produced the most significant milestones in the aviation relationship between Canada and the State of Qatar. Although enhancements have been carefully granted, the Canadian government has put the interests of travellers, shippers, businesses, and the tourism industry at the forefront of Canada's economic and trade policy.

This past November, after serving the Canadian market for 7 years and connecting Montreal – North America's most populous French-speaking metropolis – to the world, the blue skies of Canada were opened to grant an increase of one additional passenger flight per week.

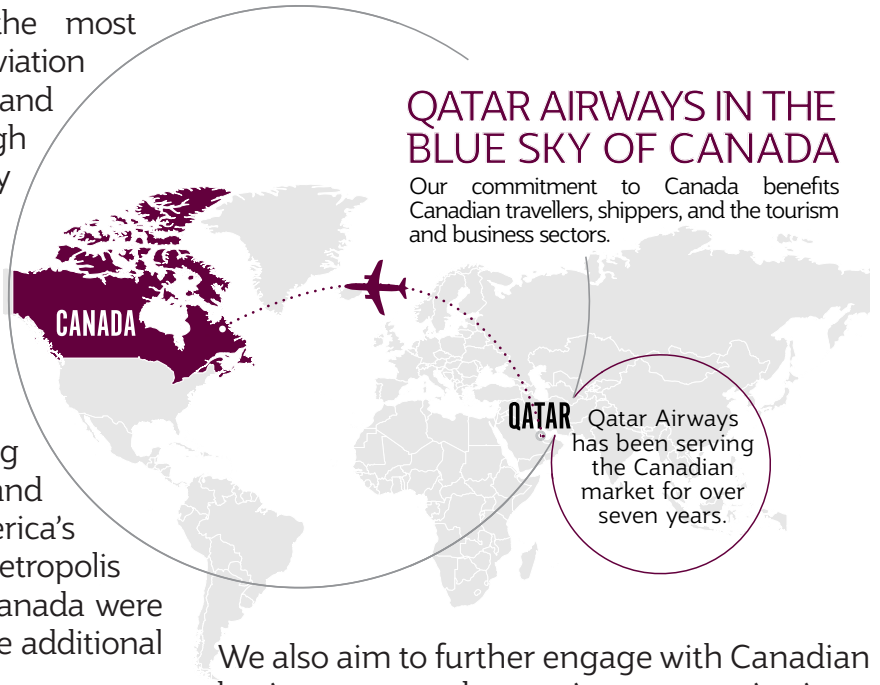
This most recent enhancement followed the Canadian government's previous relaxation of the aircraft seat cap in 2016, in addition to the opening of the route schedule in 2017, which aimed to increase the potential for partnership arrangements between airlines of Canada and Qatar.

These recent enhancements pay tribute to the excellent relations between Canada and the State of Qatar, and acknowledge the remarkable economic benefits that result from even greater market access.

As bilateral relations continue to strengthen and economic indicators are on a positive trend, Qatar Airways seeks to contribute even more to the enhancement of export opportunities for Canadian producers, manufacturers, and shippers in fast-growing emerging markets served by our global network of over 150 destinations.

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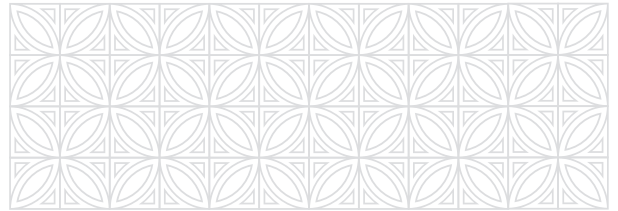

Currently, Qatar Airways is only allowed to operate four weekly passenger flights between Doha's Hamad International Airport (DOH) and Montreal's Pierre Elliott Trudeau International Airport (YUL), with a 412-seat capacity restriction.

We believe that Qatar Airways can play a key role in connecting the global community to Canada's diverse regions, "from Bonavista to Vancouver Island; from the Arctic Circle to the Great Lakes' waters."

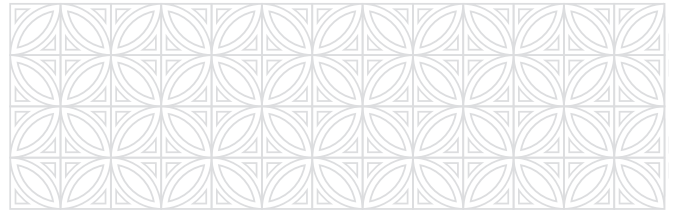
Qatar Airways is committed to providing Canadians with increased connectivity through our global network, as well as unique destinations and reasonable fares with our five-star customer service.

On 5 June 2017, Qatar Airways ceased being just a commercial airline and overnight became the only humanitarian bridge connecting the State of Qatar to the world.

Qatar's only land bridge and lifeline was shut down without warning leaving **over 2.5 million residents, including 9,000 Canadian expats**, without access to new shipments of food, medicines, and other critical supplies.
